

**LOCAL RULES**

**1. Out of Bounds: A ball lying:**

- (a) Anywhere over the fences or walls that bound the course.
- (b) On or over the line of white posts to the right of the 3rd fairway.
- (c) On or over the line before the white post to the left of the 15th, when playing the 15th hole.
- (d) On or beyond the course-side edges of the entrance drive, car park and flagged paths in front of the clubhouse.

2. Staked trees and sleeved trees are integral parts of the course.

3. **Lifting without penalty:** A ball may be lifted, cleaned and dropped within one club length but not nearer the hole, if:

- (a) It lies in a depression made by a tractor or other machinery wheel.
- (b) It lies within two club lengths of a sprinkler head and the sprinkler head is in the direct line of play to the hole.

4. Through the green (ie not in a hazard), a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted, without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

A player may not take relief under this Local Rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him to make a stroke because of interference by anything other than the condition covered by this Local Rule.

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE: Match play - Loss of Hole; Stroke Play - Two strokes**

5. A ball striking electric cables within the perimeter of the course MUST be replayed without penalty. Pylons and insulators are an integral part of the course and a ball hitting or interfered by pylons must be played as it lies.

**6. Water Hazards:**

- (a) The open ditch from the 9th to the 11th hole.
- (b) The open ditch on the left of the 14th green.

**7. Lateral Water Hazards:**

- (a) The open ditch to the left of the 2nd green.
- (b) The open ditch to the left of the 6th fairway.
- (c) The open ditch between the 11th and 12th fairways.

8. If there is doubt whether a ball is in or is lost in the water hazard to the left of the 6th fairway, the player may play another ball provisionally under any of the applicable options in Rule 26-1.

If the original ball is found outside the water hazard, the player must continue play with it.

If the original ball is found in the water hazard, the player may either:

- (a) play the original ball as it lies in the hazard; or
- (b) continue with the ball played provisionally under Rule 26-1.

If the original ball is not found or identified within the five-minute search period, the player must continue with the ball played provisionally.

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE: Match play - Loss of hole; Stroke play - Two strokes.**

9. All Ground Under Repair is marked by white lines or blue stakes. A ball lying in Ground Under Repair MUST be lifted and dropped under Rule 25-1.

10. The pumphouse and tank on the 9th hole are to be treated as immovable obstructions. (Rule 24-2 applies).

11. Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. (Rule 24-1 applies)
